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Small Scale Excellence

We believe that the educational, social and emotional needs of each child are best served in a small-scale environment, where we know every child very well. We operate our school along the lines of a caring, extended 'family' where the classes do not exceed more than 12 children per session.

Our curriculum develops excellent academic standards through each child following their own personalised learning programme. Support is given as soon as an area of weakness is identified with teachers and learning assistants offering individual workshops to overcome difficulties and consolidate learning. Content is revisited in the short term and longer term to ensure gaps in understanding do not hinder progress. Our children exceed expected progress through our focussed approach.



Children of different ages work with adults as facilitators, moving forwards or reinforcing concepts which are specific to them. Learning to Learn


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
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STEM - Science, Technology and Mathematics

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Admissions

Having visited Edward Jenner School with your child and decided you would like to join our fabulous school, you will need to contact us to arrange taster sessions. Please also complete the registration form included with this prospectus. If your child is offered a place, you will need to sign the registration form , the acceptance letter and send a cheque for the registration fee of £100. This will reserve a place for your child. You will be asked to pay a month in advance and the first month's fees to complete the enrolment.

Children may join EJS at any point during the academic year, providing there are places available. Our small classes ensure that all new arrivals are made to feel welcome and are able to integrate quickly and easily.

Edward Jenner School is a non-selective school, however we ensure that all new children coming in to the school will complement our existing cohort. We do assess all pupils for educational ability shortly after joining us, this is to inform our planning of their individual learning programme.

How Does Flexi-learning Work?


At Edward Jenner School, we are committed to providing individual learning programmes. For this reason we can easily have children who do not attend school full time. Each child completes their work at school during the day, we then assess, reflect and plan their next stage ready for whenever they are back in school. Children make progress in a safe and familiar environment, covering core skills at an appropriate and individual pace.

The Science, ICT and Technology and non-core subject courses are on specific days, this allows us to plan these subjects for the children who attend on those days. Every child is individually planned for, so you can select your days with confidence, knowing your child's individual learning needs will be met.

Enrolment and Home Education

As a Flexi- student your child will be enrolled at Edward Jenner School. This does not effect you as a Home Schooling parent. You retain the overview of your own child's educational experience. When your child is not at school you are responsible for their education - just as you are now. We are offering a partnership to ensure your child makes maximum progress in all areas of social, emotional and intellectual development.

Online and Remote Learning

At Edward Jenner School we work our hardest to maintain a fluent, relevant and valid educational experience for all of our pupils; this includes remote learning or learning online. Part of our solution has been the adoption of Google Workspace for Education. This is a set of Google tools and services that are tailored for schools and to collaborate, streamline instruction, and keep learning safe. While we have long used this platform to provide our email, we now utilise other features such as Meets, G-Drive, Classroom, Docs, Sheets and Slides. This integrated platform of apps is free and runs comfortably via the Chrome web browser on any operating system, allowing our staff to support children at

home or on our Outreach Learning Bus.

We ensure we can offer the staff quality and ratio which we believe your young people need and deserve. The individualised, reactive, and proactive aspect of our bespoke social emotional and mental health package is what makes Edward Jenner School different from other settings. We work tirelessly for each young person to support their needs in real time. Our specialist support provision has a range of professionals to draw upon and is coupled with a teaching and support staff who are constantly striving to ensure your young person makes progress, feels safe and develops the skills necessary for life.
